The Bobby Scheme



- Significantly reduces the repeat burglary rate
(from 10% to less than 4%)
- Makes people feel safer in their own homes
(the elderly and vulnerable stay in their own homes longer)
- Works with 'Homeshield' to improve well being
- Some access to Charitable financial support
(such as the Home Office 'Safer Homes Grant')

The Driving Centre



- Offers a positive and achievable outcome to deprived, under achieving and special needs young people.
- Reduces the mortality and accident rate of young people on the roads of Cambridgeshire.
- Can be used as an incentive for 'difficult' children.
(centres such as the Amber Centre and NACRO)
